### **Mesa-based Higher Education Institutions**

#### Arizona State University Polytechnic Campus

Arizona State University Polytechnic (ASU Poly), located on 600 acres adjacent to the Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport in East Mesa, is home to thousands of students and numerous undergraduate and graduate degrees programs.<sup>vi</sup>

ASU Poly assets include state-of-the-art infrastructure, research capabilities, and students and faculty in key areas.

- Arizona Center for Algae Technology and Innovation (AzCATI) serves as a hub for research, testing, and commercialization of algae-based biofuels, pharmaceuticals, and nutraceuticals. <sup>vii</sup>
- Del E. Webb Altitude Chamber Lab, used during aerospace research and training, allows students to experience the physiological effects of oxygen deprivation. viii
- Additive Manufacturing R&D Center, the Southwest's largest additive manufacturing research facility, allows students, faculty, and industry partners to stay competitive in this fast-growing industry sector. <sup>ix</sup>

#### A.T. Still University School of Osteopathic Medicine<sup>x</sup>

On the campus in Mesa, ATSU provides master's programs in Biomedical Sciences, Orthodontics, Occupational Therapy, Physician Assistant Studies, and Speech-Language Pathology, as well as doctoral programs in Audiology, Dental Medicine, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Osteopathic Medicine.

#### Benedictine University – College of Science and Health

At its Mesa campus, Benedictine University provides programs in Health Education and Promotion, Health Sciences, Nutrition and Allied Health, and Nutrition and Food Sciences, as well as preparatory programs in Chiropractic, Dentistry, Medicine, Occupational Therapy, Optometry, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, Physician Assistant, Podiatry, and Veterinary Medicine.<sup>xi</sup>

#### Alverno College

In 2022, Alverno College opened its Mesa campus, housing its new Nursing Education Center where it offers the Direct Entry Master of Science in Nursing program, which is designed for students who already hold a bachelor's degree in a nonnursing field.

#### Chandler-Gilbert Community College

Chandler-Gilbert Community College serves higher education at three locations in the Southeast Valley and offers programs in Nursing and Health Sciences.<sup>xii</sup>

#### East Valley Institute of Technology

The East Valley Institute of Technology provides training to high school students and adult learners in more than 50 occupation-specific programs at three campuses. Healthcare-related programs include Dental Assistant, Emergency Medical Technician, Medical Assistant, Nursing Assistant, Practical Nursing, Pharmacy Technician, Physical Therapy Technician, and Veterinary Assistant.<sup>xiii</sup>

#### Mesa Community College

Mesa Community College (MCC) is the largest of the 10 community colleges in the Maricopa County Community College District. MCC offers Health Sciences programs in Communication Sciences and Disorders, Dental, Emergency Medical Technology, Exercise Science, Nursing, Nutrition and Dietetics, and Paramedicine.<sup>xiv</sup>

#### **Pima Medical Institute**

Pima Medical Institute has two locations in Mesa and offers bachelor's degrees in Health Care Administration, Nursing, Radiologic Sciences, and Respiratory Therapy, and associate degrees in Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Paramedic, Radiography, Surgical Technology, and other health occupations.<sup>xv</sup>

#### Arizona College

Arizona College features programs in Nursing and Allied Health including Medical Assistant with Phlebotomy, Medical Billing and Coding, Pharmacy Technician, Dental Assistant, and Health Care Administration.<sup>xiv</sup>
